

15th August

Show and Tell

Kids do a Samayik before the session. In the session, they describe what they did in the Samayik.

EG: 'I recited two verses of the Bhaktamar Stotra'.

16th August

Crossword/Puzzle

In the session, kids will do a Jain crossword and Quiz, led by a Gyanshala teacher.

17th August

Word Antakshari:

Kids will have to say Jain words beginning from the last letter of the word said by the previous participant.

EG: Sanchi: Mahavirswami
Arham: Indradev

18th August

Bhajan/Instruments:

Kids will recite a Jain Bhajan/play an instrument that they have prepared before the session.

19th August

Drawing:

Kids under 7 will draw/paint a picture before the session related to a Jain symbol and they will then present it in the session, talking about it for a minute.

EG: I drew one of the 14 dreams of Mother Trishla. The elephant shows that the child born would have a very good character.

20th August

Stories about fasting:

Kids will listen to Saminiji present stories about fasting and explain the importance of fasting.

EG: the story of Rishabdev's fast and the 108 pots of sugarcane juice

21st August Points Tracker:

The 1st, 2nd, 3rd winners in the Points tracker competition will be announced (one set for above 7s and another for under 7s).

22nd August Concluding Talk:

Gyanshala teachers and respected Saminijis will conclude the Paryushan festivities.
